



Competition Announcement

Art. 1 Object

The object of this notice concerns of a journalism award.

"Degustivina, the culture of the territory", founded by the Enos association, the organizer of the **Degustivina** event. "**Degustivina, the culture of the territory**" is assigned to those articles published in periodicals, newspapers, agencies, websites, national and international radio-television broadcasters that have as a main theme the history of the area along **the highway 624 that goes from Palermo to Sciacca**.

With a particular reference to the historical and archaeological sites and description of the beautiful scenarios together with the oenological, gastronomic, artistic e cultural resources. Since the area has got what it takes to become one of the most important destinations in the world.

Art. 2 Who can apply

Participations are opened to Italian and foreign professional journalists and publicists subscribed to the Order of Journalists. The journalists who are members of the jury and those who have family links or contactual working relationships with the jurors or the organization are excluded.

Art. 3 Deadline and terms of participation

Articles, services, or programmes admitted to the contest must be sent in the period between the beginning of the year 2010 to 30 September 2010. Each candidate can submit one article, one program or service.

The selected works admitted to the contest will be officially reported by the members of the jury and must be delivered by 10 October 2010– to the address **via Marchese Ugo 56 – 90100 Palermo**. **The paper work must previously delivered by e-mail to concorso.degustivina@gmail.com, in pdf.**

Art. 4 How to participate

The authors nominated by the jury and the other candidates must send to the administrative department the article or service according to the referee section (see section 5 of this notice), stating to be registered in the Order of Journalist.

A brief curriculum vitae of your professional experience and a signature to give the authorization to use your personal data according to the article D.L. 196/2003, including the title and the date of release of the article or the service.

Therefore, each work must be provided by:

- n. 1 the original copy of the article published, internet text
or
- n.1 dvd copy or vhs of the television service.

n.1 copy on cd rom a tape of the radio broadcast.

The works written in foreign language must have a copy translated in Italian.

All the works selected or recieved will not be returned.The awarded works may be used with descretion by the promotor.

The works selected or delivered to the administrative office (art.9 of the notice) later than the fixed terms will not be admitted.In all cases,to be admitted to the contest,it is necessary to exhibit an unequivocal proof that works has been braocasted before the scheduled closing time of this announcement.

Applying is free and requires the agreement and the observation of all the rules descibed in this announcement.

Art. 5 Awards

According to the conditions descibed in the Art.1 of this announcement,it is agreed to assign 2 awards divided for each section.

1.Award entitled "**The story of the territoriy**" for the best original work published and the most widespread among all those recieved.A 1.000,00 euros (one thousand euros) will be assigned,plus 48 bottles of wine produced in this territory.

2. Award entitled "**History forgotten Ancient-Jetas Mount-Entella Adranone-Selinunte**" For the best document or original work published and widely spread among all those recieved. A 1.000,00 euros (one thousand euros) plus 48 bottles of wine produced in this territory.

Art. 6 Criteria of evaluations

According to the selected works,the jury focuses a particular attention to the emotional expression and the communicative skills of the candidate,who should be able to improve the value of the subject treated and the object indicated in the Art.1 of the notice.More over the originality and the novelty,the style,the completeness of information given to the reader must be published by a network or a site. Decisions related to the award assignments will be taken by the jury.

Art. 7 The Jury

The jury consists of 7 components,primarily journalists,divided in the following groups:

- 3professional journalists or publicists,of whom at least one braodcasting.
- 2 producers of the 624.
- 1 member of the award comittee
- 1 member of the archeological group

The jury expresses its own opinion by voting,according to the majority of votes as each mmember can give only one vote.

The jury nominates and may be supported by a "technical committee"that undertakes a first selection according to features and categories of the contest.A limited number of works will be submitted to the jury in addition to the complete list of work wich the jury reserves to examine.The jury carries out all tasks,such as convocating and administrating the enos association,which offers the awards.When the jury takes its final decision,a member of the administration is nominated.He is to be encharged to inform the organizer comittee of the results by 30 October.

Art. 8 Awards and Dissemination

The winners are invited to collect the award on the occasion of the next edition of Degustivina To be held in Palermo in the end of November 2010.

Art. 9 The istitutional Secretariat of the award

The istitutional secretariat where all operations of the jury are held and a where all works must be delivered toghether with the documents descibed in the Art.4 take place in the Enos Association.

Art. 10 Regulatory Aspects and Identifications

The money award is to be regarded as exempt from the group of those awarded for the event according to the art. 6 lettera A comma 1 DPR 430/2001.The awarded works their ownership according to the copyright,but may be used by the organizer committee.

All candidates agree to have the articles and services sent, used and published, even in part. Maintaining the right to be mentioned as authors. The secretariat of the award and the organizer committee are exempt from any responsibility if any claim may arise according to the originality of the work, the copyright and creativeness of the works or eventual imitations or appropriations.

Art. 11 Changes

The organizing committee reserves the right to make changes if necessary and due to force majeure. Of course it will undertake the task to report the notice firstly to those responsible to designate the juries and then to broadcast it through its own information channels and the press.
